

**Government bureaux/departments
which have moved out of CBD since May 2009**

Customs and Excise Department:

The offices of the Customs and Excise Department at Harbour Building, Rumsey Street Multi-Storey Car Park Building, Middle Road Carpark Building (government-owned premises with a total floor area of 9 800 square metres) and Nan Fung Tower in Central (leased premises with a floor area of about 675 square metres) were relocated to the Customs Headquarters Building in North Point in the second half of 2010.

Security Bureau:

The office of the Security Bureau at Prince's Building in Central (leased premises with a floor area of about 176 square metres) was relocated to the Kowloon East Government Offices in November 2009.

Education Bureau and Department of Health:

The offices of the Education Bureau and the Department of Health at Wu Chung House in Wan Chai (leased premises with a floor area of about 1 825 square metres) were relocated to newly leased premises in Kwun Tong in December 2010.

Hongkong Post:

The office of the Retail Business Division of Hongkong Post at ING Tower in Sheung Wan (leased premises with a floor area of about 183 square metres) was relocated to newly leased premises in Cheung Sha Wan in July 2010.
